### Principal's Report - Kelly Laverne

The Falcon Family Fest was well attended and a big success. Thanks to the PTO for helping out with their raffle. The Book Fair took in more money than ever before. The second semester just started and conferences are planned for February 15th and 16th. There is no school on the 16th and 17th.

There will be a Community Day on February 22nd after the holiday weekend. Students will be making posters and volunteers are welcome to come help out from 10:15 - 11:15.

On February 27th, incoming fifth graders will be touring the school on Fly Up Day. A virtual informational event will be held for their parents on March 1st from 6:30 - 7:30 pm.

Plans are being made by Mr. Centis to partner with the Five Oaks Museum by bringing a speaker to address all the students at school. They had asked for \$300 for 30 students to tour the museum, which is cost prohibitive.

Outdoor school for sixth graders will be overnight this year from April 25th - 28th at Camp Harlow in Eugene and Camp Trickle Creek in Salem. There will likely be a gear drop of at the school the night before students leave from 5-7pm. More information will be sent out in early March and a Q & A session is planned with camp directors for parents on March 8th from 6-7pm in the school library.
